The Division of Pediatric Cardiology in the Department of Pediatrics at the Icahn School of Medicine at Mount Sinai (ISMMS) and the Children's Heart Center at Mount Sinai seek a full-time, BC/BE pediatric cardiologist at any rank with expertise in cardiac imaging to join our practice.

Our cardiac imaging team consists of 6 full-time faculty and 9 sonographers, who perform and interpret 8,500 echocardiograms, 200 cardiac MRIs and 80 cardiac CTs per year. We perform 2,400 fetal echocardiograms and consultations per year as part of our multidisciplinary Fetal Heart Program. We support active surgical and interventional programs and subspecialty programs including heart failure/transplantation, adult congenital heart disease, pulmonary hypertension and cardiovascular genetics.

The successful candidate will not only provide clinical imaging services, but also mentor and educate trainees, including categorical and advanced cardiac imaging fellows, and participate in scholarly pursuits to advance the academic mission of the division. Resources include a divisional research assistant, multi-vendor imaging platforms and advanced analytic software. Other clinical responsibilities will include participation in general inpatient and outpatient cardiology care.

The candidate will join 16 other Children's Heart Center pediatric cardiology faculty members as well as six categorical pediatric cardiology fellows, one advanced imaging fellow, one ACHD fellow, two pediatric cardiothoracic surgeons, a dedicated pediatric cardiac ICU and pediatric cardiac anesthesiology service.

Requirements:

- 1) Medical degree from an accredited program (MD, DO, MBBS)
- 2) New York State License or eligibility
- 3) Board Certified or Board Eligible in Pediatric Cardiology
- 4) Preference give to those who completed an additional 4th year of training in advanced cardiac imaging
- 5) An interest in development of a novel program for Mount Sinai Pediatric Cardiology
- 6) Meet eligibility requirements for appointment to the Icahn School of Medicine at Mount Sinai
